Our mission is to provide middle and high school African-American students with hands-on activities, educational field trips and opportunities, and career skills in the Arts and STEM fields, necessary to be productive citizens in the 21st century workforce.

Last July community donors provided the opportunity for 28 students to attend 17 days of this Art and STEM Camp. Students were engaged in numerous activities such as building airplanes, robots and solar cars.
