## **Your VOTE will make a Difference**

November 3, 2020 is an important date. It is the date we vote to determine the political leadership on the national, state, and local level. There are methods to vote if you do not feel that you want to vote in person on November 3<sup>rd</sup>.

### **REGISTERING TO VOTE**

If you are not registered to vote in NC and lived in state for at least 30 days, you can register by completing and submitting a voter registration form to Orange County Board of Elections (OCBOE).

- You will need a government issued photo ID with your current address on it. If ID does not have current address, you must have a bill with the correct address along with your name.
- Registration forms are available online at Board of Elections' website, public libraries, or DMV website and offices.

During early voting, in addition to voting, you can register, change your address, turn in completed absentee ballots.

### **ELECTION DAY**

- If you vote, in-person, on Election Day you must go to your precinct polling place.
- You can vote from 6:30 a.m. until 7:30 p.m. If you are in line before 7:30 p.m. you will be able to vote.
- Check your precinct voting place because it may have changed. Some had to be relocated for space to ensure social distancing.
  - If you live in Northside, you vote at First Baptist Church, 106 North Roberson Street, Chapel Hill
  - If you live in Pines Knolls Community you are now in Westwood Precinct (formerly Lincoln Precinct) and you will be voting at Frank P. Graham Elementary School, 101 Smith Level Road, Chapel Hill but you will be in gym this year.
  - If you live in Lion's Club Precinct you will vote at Carrboro Elementary School

A registered voter or their near relative or legal guardian must complete, sign and return the request form. We begin mailing ballots on September 4, 2020.
