Starting in our 151st year as a church body, we want to focus back on our building project. We have successfully raised and paid over 1 million dollars in planning activities and land mortgage payments: 1) we successfully paid off Phase 1 debts to get through the city planning requirements 2) we have paid off 2/3rd of the land mortgage that started at \$725,000. These 20 plus acres are the new legacy of St. Paul AME church. We want to build our church community within a community already with a rich legacy and future. We know the Vision is grounded in the faith of many believers and therefore we know that this blessings will be bountiful. As we stand before this simple marker of a walkway, it presents the names of those who have been and currently are a part of this legacy. It represents the sacrificial gifts given by those who have been a part of the Vision since 2006 when the pledge program began. 
