Are you accepting books this year?

Unfortunately we will not be accepting books however, the Chapel Hill Public Library would love your gently used books. Donations are accepted on W, Sat, Sun (9am-5pm).

Where can I donate old shoes, torn or soiled clothing and linens?

Please do not throw these items into the landfill. There are **Green Zone Bins** all over town that will accept unusable clothing, linens, textiles, shoes and accessories. (Exxon Station on E. Franklin Street, Eastgate Shopping Center – to the left of Ulta, Food Lion, 50060 Governors Drive, East Chapel Hill HS bus lot. See ABC Sale webpage for more options).

Where can I donate old computers and monitors?

Where can I donate an old children's car seat?

In spring 2025, Target will accept and recycle all types of car seats, including: infant car

seats, convertible car seats, car seat bases, harness or booster car seats, as well as car seats that are expired or damaged. Guests will receive a 20% off Target Circle™ Bonus for trading in any one of these items. Car seats can only be traded in at a Target store. Target will have drop-off boxes for guests' unwanted car seats located near Guest Services in the spring.

Where can I donate glass vases?
